A Questionnaire Investigation of the Actual Conditions of Health among Kyushu Dental College Students

Since little is known about their actual conditions of health, we conducted a mark-sheet questionnaire investigation of dental students in the 2nd through the 6th years of study at Kyushu Dental College, as part of a program of educational reform. The survey was carried out for 489 individuals. The percentage of students responding to the questionnaire was 82.8 percent.

As for questions concerning health, 25.4 percent of the students have been more or less worried about health matters, and 10.8 percent have gone to the hospital as outpatients. 27.1 percent reported a mental affliction. These ratios tended to be lower as the number of years of study increased from two to five, but the 6^{th} year students had a high response rate.
